Tips on How to Use Pleo Muc Eye Drops:

- Topical application 1-2 drops in each eye, once to twice daily.
- Preservative free, can be used with contact lenses.
- To avoid contamination, do not touch tip of container to the eye or any other surface. Replace cap or cover after use.
- Apply eye drops to the outer palpebral tissue (outer corner) of the eye, as this allows the drops to move from the outer corner to inner corner, passing over the whole eye for optimal effect.
- Please note: avoid applying eye drops to the inner corner of the eye, as it contains the tear ducts where the drops will drain away without enough time to take effect.
